

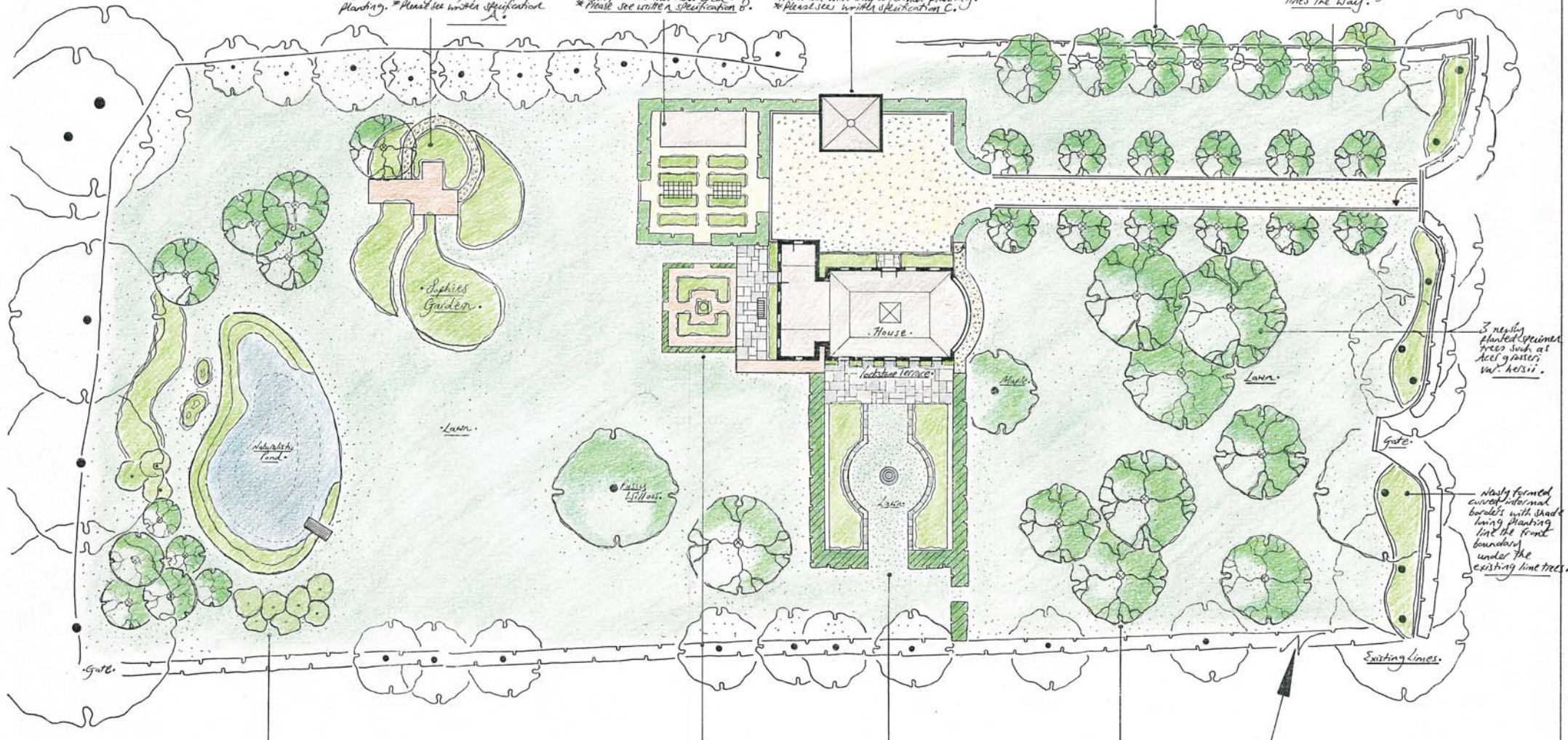
*Sophies Garden is placed at the far West end of the garden with a neat straight path from the west driveway. A central area of brick paving is surrounded by both informal planting. * Please see written specification.*

*A newly formed kitchen garden with eight formal beds. A neat brick path leads the way through towards Sophie's Garden. Brick paving forms the hardstanding and Herbaceous Hedging surrounds and protects this new area. * Please see written specification D.*

*A newly formed courtyard area adjoins the garage and also becomes an area for car parking. This area is enclosed by newly planted Hornbeam hedging. Two neat borders are set alongside the house with simple formal planting. * Please see written specification C.*

A newly planted line of Cotoneaster plus smaller plants which give privacy to the north and also discourage wildlife.

A newly laid gravel drive leads up to the courtyard and house. An avenue of Prunus Spinda is replanted with Juncus reticulata ceonae lines the way.



3 newly planted specimen trees such as Aesculus, var. hessei.

Newly formed curved informal border with shade loving planting under the existing lime trees.

*Newly formed large naturalistic pond with solid specimens of planting such as Liquidambar, Syringa, Forsythia, Amelanchier, and Cornus alba, Sibirica following the line of the pond. Marginal and aquatic planting follows the edge and Swellie pools. * Please see written specification F.*

*A newly formed herb garden with centrally placed lime tree and box hedging, gives a strong focal point from the kitchen. A large Yorkstone terrace is set by the herb garden and leads to the kitchen. Sealed planting is set along the west-facing kitchen wall. * Please see written specification E.*

*A large neat Yorkstone terrace with two plants in stone in large pots, gives ample room for entertaining. This leads on to double Yorkstone borders and a circular lawn, giving strong views to the south. A circular engraved stone is placed in the centre of the lawn providing a good focal point. * Please see written specification D.*

A group of five newly planted small specimen garden trees such as Castanea, Cornus alternifolia, Davidia involuta, and Cereus sitiquastrum.

Soil: Clay with flint base/ pH 7 normal.

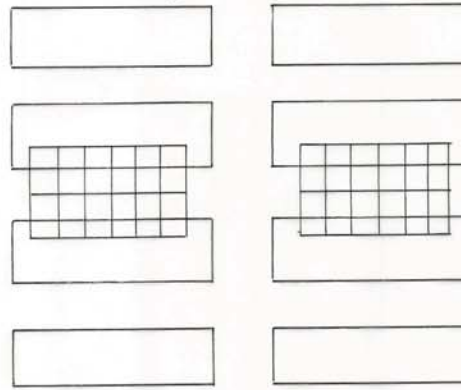

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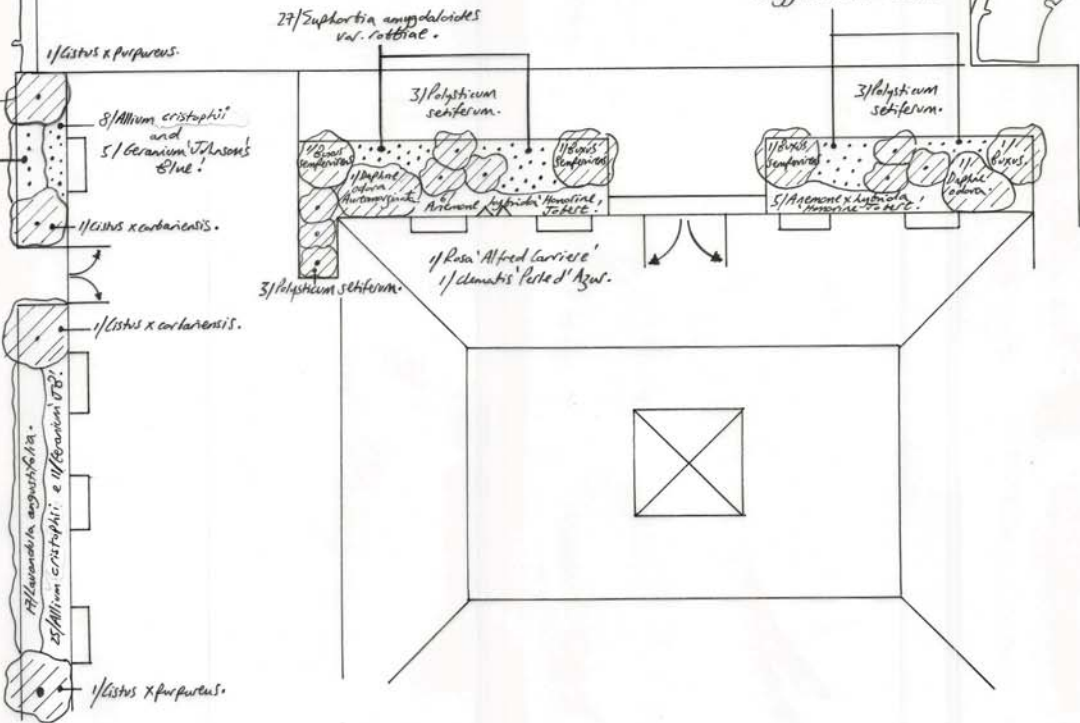
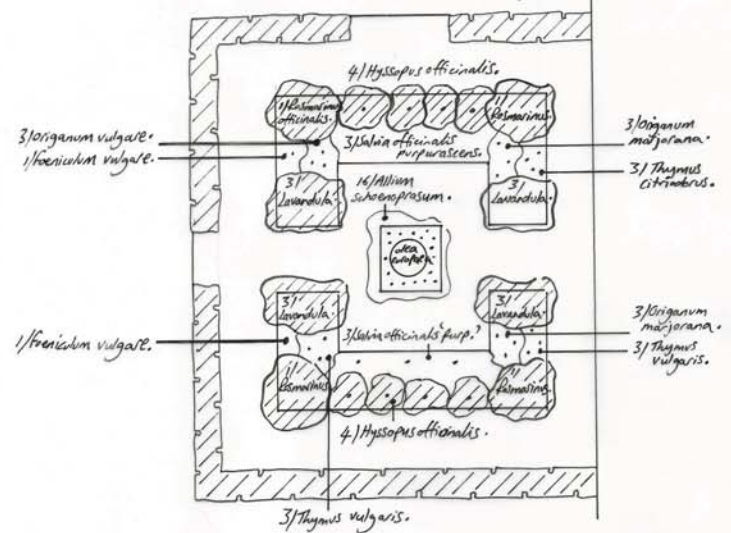
125 *Carpinus betulus* hedging.

General ideas for Kitchen Garden:

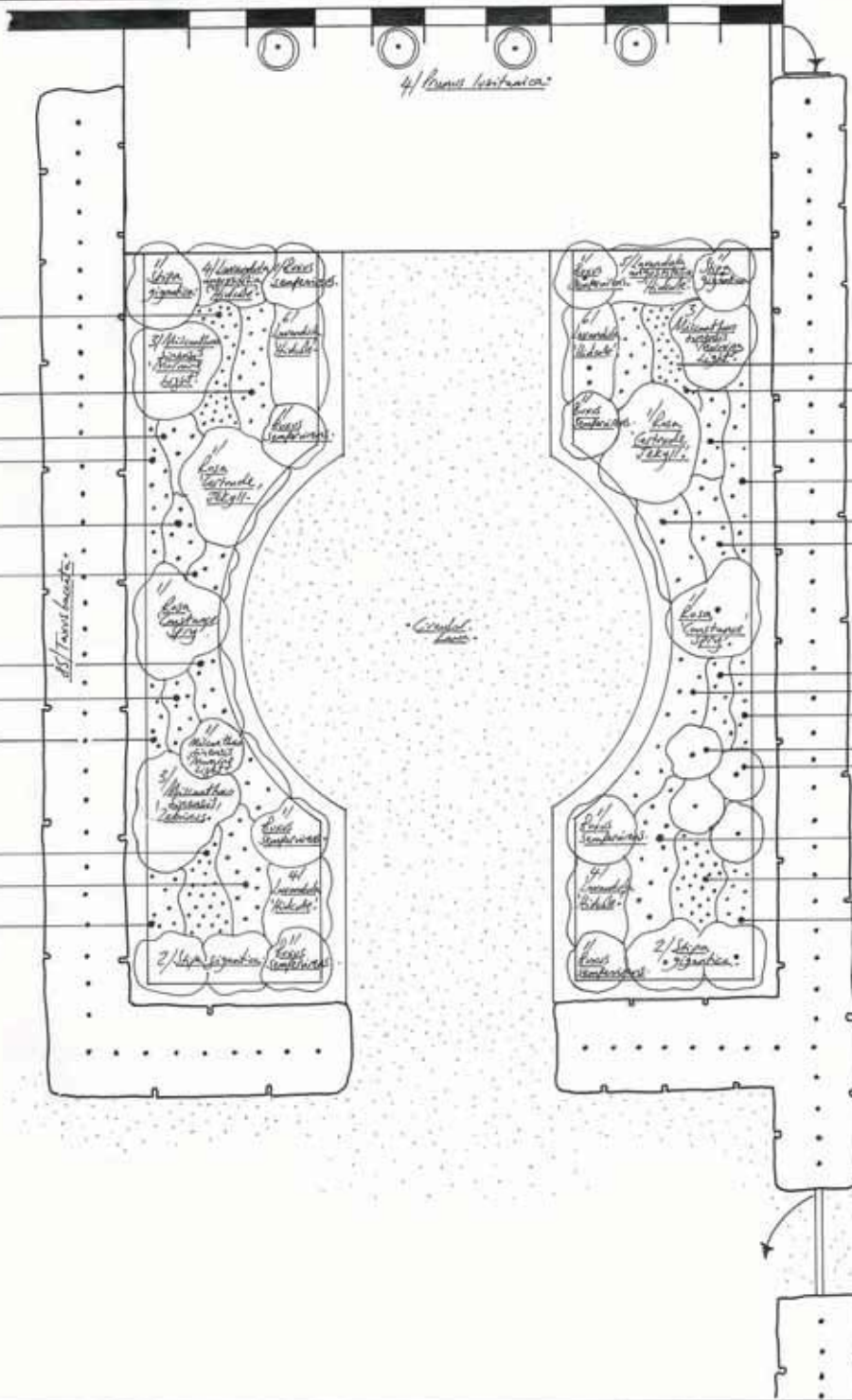
- Hazel wigwams of old fashioned street fans such as 'Cipani'.
- Ebbot can be grown along the edges of raised beds.
- Grow calendula for hoverflies.
- French climbing beans for iron tunnel.
- Vegetables to be decided by Mr and Mrs Connolly.
- Incorporate plenty of coarse grit and manure in kitchen and herb garden to help with drainage.

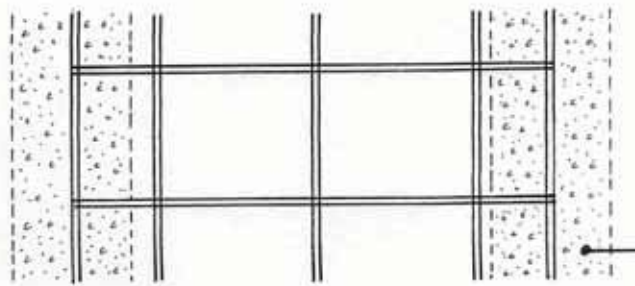

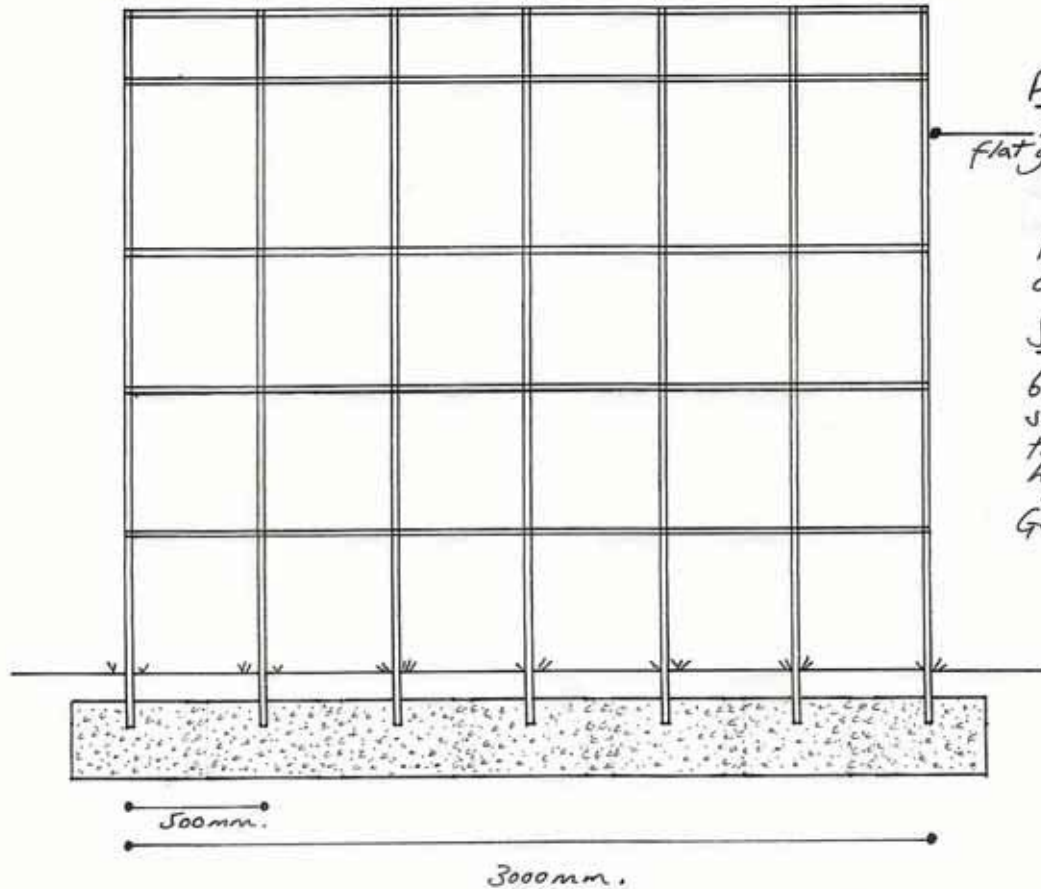
